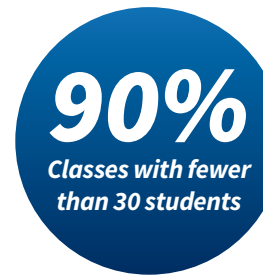
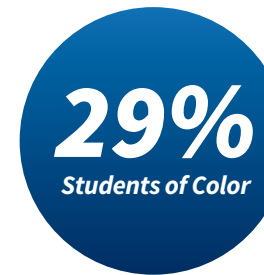
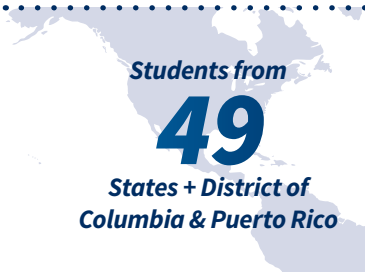

APPLYING TO SU IS EASY!

There are two ways to apply: **SU's application or Common App.** You only need to complete one:

SU APPLICATION

Shenandoah offers an application that can be submitted directly through our website. Students can begin and save their progress to return and complete at any time.

COMMON APP

Common App is an undergraduate college admissions application that applicants may use to seamlessly apply to any of more than 1,000 member colleges and universities, including SU.

Applicants to Shenandoah should complete a strong college preparatory schedule. Minimum high school course expectations include:

English: 4 units

Math: 3 units (Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry)
Students applying for health professions, nursing and business majors are recommended to complete a minimum of 4 units of math.

Students applying for engineering are required to complete pre-calculus with a B- or better.

Science: 2 units

Students applying for science, nursing and health professions majors are recommended to complete a minimum of 4 units of science.

Foreign Language: 3 units highly recommended

This includes any foreign language taught as part of a high school curriculum, including American Sign Language. Students are encouraged to complete 4 units of the same language at the high school level which will meet minimum language requirements for our College of Arts & Sciences majors.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES FOR FALL 2025 ADMISSION

AUGUST 1, 2024

2025 undergraduate application opens! Students are strongly encouraged to apply early in their senior year (September to December). We practice Early Action and then rolling admissions for most undergraduate programs.

SEPTEMBER 2024

Prescreening and audition cycle opens for Shenandoah Conservatory. Music, theatre and dance applicants must complete the audition, interview, and/or portfolio review. Students will be informed of an admission decision by March 2025.

OCTOBER 2024

Applicants may begin to submit the 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Shenandoah will begin to award comprehensive financial aid packages after January 15, 2025 to admitted students who have submitted the FAFSA. Dates contingent on the U.S. Department of Education.

Application opens for the Honors Program.

Registration opens for Early Assurance Pathway to graduate health professions consideration for pre-athletic training, pre-occupational therapy, pre-pharmacy, pre-physical therapy, pre-physician assistant studies, and pre-public health.

*Firm deadline means that applications will not be accepted after the deadline. Shenandoah University reserves the right to close admissions to any academic program once it is filled.

**Priority deadline means that applications may still be accepted after the deadline if space remains available.

NOVEMBER 4, 2024

Early Action application deadline and then rolling admissions for most undergraduate programs. After the initial Early Action deadline of November 4, when an applicant's file is complete, an admission decision should be made within three weeks.

DECEMBER 4, 2024

FIRM admission application deadline for Musical Theatre applications.*

FEBRUARY 14, 2025

FIRM deadline for all other Shenandoah Conservatory programs.*

FIRM deadline for Early Assurance Pathway to graduate health professions consideration for pre-athletic training, pre-occupational therapy, pre-pharmacy, pre-physical therapy, pre-physician assistant studies, and pre-public health.*

FIRM deadline for Presidential Scholarship consideration.*

MARCH 1, 2025

Final auditions for Shenandoah Conservatory programs.

MARCH 15, 2025

FAFSA priority deadline.** To receive a comprehensive financial aid package, a student must submit a 2025-26 FAFSA.

MAY 1, 2025

Priority deadline to accept offer of admission for the fall 2025 semester by submitting the enrollment deposit.**

SHENANDOAH IS AFFORDABLE

Shenandoah is committed to supporting its talented and diverse student body. The cost of a Shenandoah education is met by combining the resources of parents, students, and state and federal government aid, as well as the university and other organizations. This includes:

- Academic merit scholarships
- Need-based scholarships and grants
- Conservatory awards based on the results of music, theatre or dance auditions
- Virginia Tuition Assistance Grant (VTAG) for Virginia residents
- Virginia United Methodist Conference scholarships & ministerial grants
- Work-study program
- Federal and private loans

Shenandoah's most prestigious scholarship is the **Presidential Scholarship. Only 10 of these extremely competitive scholarships are awarded each year.** Admitted students who have earned a 3.8 high school GPA (weighted GPA is accepted) will automatically be considered if their admission application is completed by February 14 (firm deadline).

APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

Complete the 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA): The FAFSA is used to determine eligibility for aid such as grants, student and parent loans and work-study awards. For priority consideration, families should submit the 2025-26 FAFSA between October 2024 and March 2025.

COST AND AID

100% of Shenandoah undergraduate students receive an academic merit scholarship! And, the average comprehensive financial aid package for the 2023-24 academic year was \$27,109!

AP, IB HIGHER-LEVEL & CLEP EXAMS
